- A formal written application must be made to St James the Great Church and authorisation granted by the church, **Before** the introduction of **Any** memorial and **Before** the introduction of **Any** additional inscription to an existing Ledger Stone.
- 2. A **Maximum** of One Small Floral Tribute permitted on each Ledger Stone.
- 3. No Glass Containers/Vases permitted.
- 4. No Brightly Coloured Containers permitted.
- The Floral Tribute Must be Placed on the Ledger Stone and Not on the Grass Between the Ledger Stones.
- 6. Only Cut Flowers or Seasonally Appropriate Silk Flowers are permitted, but they must be removed once they are decaying or have become faded. Please use one of our plain Green Spiked Vases sited by our Water Butt for flowers. Please return our Vases once you have finished with them so that others may use them. Thank you.
- 7. Plastic Flowers and Metal Flowers are not permitted.
- 8. No Objects are permitted.
 i.e No Toys, Ornaments, Balloons, Photographs, Candles, Lights, etc.
- 9. No Floral Tributes or Objects are to be left on or around the Bench in the Churchyard.
- 10. The PCC reserves the right to remove any Objects which are not, or have ceased to be, Authorised under these Regulations and any Objects that are decaying or faded.
- 11. The PCC accepts No Responsibility for any Floral Tributes left in the Churchyard.
